



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Report on Yoga and Games for the Children at Government Observation Home, Coimbatore



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Report on Agricultural Training Programme for Children at Government Observation Home, Coimbatore

The Department of Extension Services of Sri Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya College of Education (Autonomous) organised an Agricultural Training Programme for the Children (CCL - Children in Conflict with Law) residing at the Government Observation Home in Coimbatore from 06.12.2022 to 27.12.2022. The programme aimed at educating and empowering the children by providing them with knowledge and skills related to various agricultural practices, including methods of farming, drip irrigation techniques, mushroom cultivation and home gardening.

The programme began with an introduction to various farming techniques. Experts from the agricultural field conducted interactive sessions to familiarize the children with different agricultural practices, such as organic farming, integrated pest management and crop rotation. The children learned about soil preparation, seed selection and proper plant care.

The programme emphasised the importance of home gardening as a means of sustainable food production. 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Report of Swachh Bharat Activities



On 19th April 2023 morning 8:15 am, we started from the college using buses and bikes. We reached at Palamalai Hill approximately 9.15 am and parked vehicles before gathering together. 
