
2. Gender Sensitization


All the student-teachers actively participated in the programme. Finally, Sri. B. Logeswaran, B.Ed. II year student-teacher proposed vote of thanks.

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
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8. Webinar / Periodic Lecture A Story of the Making of National Education Policy-2020

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
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10. Periodic Lecture Programme on Philosophical Context



1. Micro Teaching

Micro teaching practice sessions for the first year student-teachers studying B.Ed. programme were organised from 05.12.2022 to 09.12.2022 respectively. The student-teachers were divided into two groups. Each group has eight students.

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2. Observation (Teaching Phase I)

As a part of the Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) program, the students are required to undergo observation teaching practice in schools to gain hands-on experience in teaching. From 13.02.2023 to 10.03.2023, a group of B.Ed students from our college went for observation teaching practice in various schools.

They observed the classes of different teachers and noted down the teaching methods used, teaching aids, and classroom management techniques. They also observed how the teacher communicated with the students, how they motivated the students and how they handled difficult situations in the classroom.



After observing the classes, the students were given an opportunity to interact with the teacher and clarify their doubts. They were also asked to prepare lesson plans for the topics they observed and presented them in front of their peers and faculty members.

During the observation teaching practice, the students were closely monitored by the faculty members of our college, who regularly visited the schools and interacted with the students and the teachers. 

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The Mentor-Mentee system is active throughout the academic year. The mentors offered active guidance and take remedial measure if necessary to the mentees as they navigate their under graduate programme of teacher education. The mentors used to collect personal information from their mentees discretely, keeping in mind that certain issues might be sensitive and with care to ensure that all information volunteered by the wards are of their free will. This was done so that the mentor cognizant the context of his mentees and can offer effective assistance.


Nearly 4,000 people including school students, teachers, public and educationists were benefited from the exhibition. The programme assisted student teachers develop their academic and social skills.

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
Quit India Movement Day




Birth Anniversary of Sir C.V. Raman



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
Celebration of Communal Harmony Week

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
