1. Vehicle Parking






The educational institution encourages its day scholars to use public transportation or bicycles to commute to college. This not only reduces pollution caused by automobile exhaust but also promotes physical activity, thereby benefiting the students' health and instilling a sense of social responsibility. The college provides designated parking areas for bicycles and two-wheelers. Students and teachers who have to travel from faraway places use two-wheelers, but they are instructed to park them in a specific order in the parking lot, which has a concrete tile pavement. 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2. Common Rooms separately for Boys and Girls



The institution caters exclusively to male students and therefore deems it unnecessary to provide separate common rooms for male and female students. However, co-education is practiced in post-graduate courses, and as a result, the institution offers separate washroom facilities for both male and female students, including those who are enrolled through the study centers that function within the institution. The common room designated for male students is furnished with camp cots and personal space to cater to their needs, and it is expected that student teachers will maintain the room's cleanliness and tidiness. The room is well-ventilated and features a window that offers a scenic view of nature, providing students with a refreshing environment to unwind. The College of Education takes into consideration the unique needs and requirements of its students and provides well-equipped common room facilities for male students, personal space, and a scenic view of nature. The institution also ensures separate washroom facilities for male and female students, promoting inclusivity and gender equality. These facilities contribute to creating a comfortable and conducive living environment for student teachers during their time at the college.



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3. Recreational Facility





Student teachers, in order to alleviate stress and enhance their working potential, utilize recreational facilities that are primarily designated for use by resident students. These facilities include indoor games such as Chess and Carom Board, as well as additional amenities like a gym and table tennis in the Physical Education room, which are utilized for recreation in a structured manner. 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4. First Aid and Medical



A first aid kit is a set of supplies and equipment used to provide immediate 7medical assistance. Within an institution, a first aid box is usually available with all the necessary materials. The contents of a first aid kit typically include adhesive dressings, pain medication, antiseptic lotion, bandages, cotton balls or swabs, hand sanitizer, oral dehydration salts, ointments, and scissors. In the vicinity, there is a hospital called "Dharma Vaithiyasalai (Charitable Dispensary)" which is managed by Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya administration and serves as a place where student teachers can receive emergency medical care and treatment. Qualified medical personnel are also available at the convent located on campus.

" Charitable Dispensary"

The Charitable Dispensary of the Vidyalaya caters to a population of around 8000 students and 800 staff members and their families besides a large number of underprivileged people residing in the surrounding areas. In addition to regular general consultation, the dispensary also offers consultation by specialists in the areas of orthopaedics, neurology, paediatrics, cardiology, gynaecology, diabetes, skin, asthma, dental, eye, ENT, general surgery, etc. On an average, around 150 patients visit the dispensary for consultation every day. As part of the medical services, many free medical camps are held for the benefit of the underprivileged.





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5. Transport

6. Book Bank






The library has established a Book Bank to assist student teachers who are keen to excel in their studies but face financial difficulties in purchasing books. The Book Bank is stocked with donated textbooks and reference materials, generously provided by volunteers. These resources are distributed to the student teachers in accordance with the prescribed guidelines, with the approval of the teacher educators. Upon completion of their semester exams, the beneficiaries are expected to return the books to the Book Bank. The Book Bank is primarily supported by donations from alumnae and teacher educators. Specialization books in optional subjects and the collection of study materials enable the student teachers to prepare for the competitive exams such as CTET, TNTET, PGTRB, NET, SET, TNPSC, UPSC, and SSC.





7. Safe Drinking Water

It is the fundamental right of every living being on this planet to have access to safe, clean and hygienic potable water. The campus provides clean drinking water that is purified through the Reverse Osmosis process and is available in both hot and cold temperatures. The water tanks, purifiers, dispensers, and storage containers are regularly cleaned and maintained with utmost care to ensure their proper functioning.

In addition to providing access to safe and clean drinking water, the College of Education places a strong emphasis on maintaining high standards of hygiene and sanitation. The campus has implemented a robust system to ensure that the drinking water available to students is of the highest quality. The water is purified through the Reverse Osmosis (RO) process, which removes impurities, contaminants, and harmful substances, ensuring that the water is safe for consumption. The campus has designated water tanks, purifiers, dispensers, and storage containers strategically placed across the premises to ensure easy access for students. These facilities are regularly cleaned and maintained by a dedicated team to ensure that they are in optimal working condition. 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
9. Canteen
