




The program was a great success and received positive feedback from the students. The Placement Cell of the college also provided further guidance and support to students who needed additional assistance with their interview preparation.




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On-Campus Placement Drive




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On-Campus Placement Drive


The selection procedure for the placement drive included a written test, demo sessions, and a personal interview.




Personal Interview:

Professional Conduct:



The placement cell must ensure that the privacy of the students and alumni members is maintained. They should refrain from sharing any personal information on the group and take necessary measures to secure the group.

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




Selection Procedure: The selection procedure for the placement drive included three stages - a written test, demo sessions, and a personal interview.


