





This historic discourse held great significance in Indian history, and it is essential to commemorate this special day and spread the teachings of Swami Vivekananda throughout the country.

In honour of Swami Vivekananda's speech at the Chicago Parliament on September 11, 1893, Sri Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya College of Education celebrated the Universal Brotherhood Day in the college. 


