As per the guidelines of the University Grants Commission, the programme has been conducted for ten days period from 27th October 2022 to 08th November 2022.

Objectives of the Programme

- To ensure a smooth transition from undergraduate or postgraduate backgrounds to the professional requirements of a B.Ed. programme.
- To introduce foundational teaching skills and standards required in the profession.

- To introduce student teachers to available resources, including libraries, laboratories and other support services.
- To acquaint with various cocurricular activities and extracurricular opportunities.



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The purpose of conducting Student Induction Programme is to help new student teachers adjust and feel comfortable in the new environment, inculcate in them the ethos and culture of the institution, help them build bonds with senior student teachers and faculty members, and expose them to a sense of larger purpose and self-exploration. The programme engaged with them as soon as they came into the institution, before the commencement of regular classes. At the start of the induction, the incumbents learned about the institutional policies, processes, practices, culture and values, and their mentor groups were formed. It helped them acclimatize with the new surroundings, develop bonds with fellow student teachers and faculty members, sensitivity towards various issues of social relevance and imbibe human values in them so as to become teachers, the responsible citizens of the nation.

8. Extra-Curricular Activities in College and other opportunities.


