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Report Mentoring / Academic Counselling

Sri Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya College of Education has been organising Student Induction Programme for the newly admitted student-teachers to familiarise with the institution in which there is an orientation session on mentoring services. Being a mentor each teacher is allotted some students as their mentees. The college of Education has been conducting Mentor-Mentee meeting periodically to discuss about various issues and to make necessary measure to overcome the issues.

- The College of Education has a Zero Hour mentoring system where each Mentor teacher meets their mentees for discussion which assist to identify the strengths and weaknesses of the student-teachers. The problems and issues faced by the student-teachers are discussed in person with the mentor teacher through informal, open chats and discussions with them and also student-teachers may get an opportunity to report their needs through the Mentoring System functioning effectively in the college. The curriculum, syllabus, library, ICT facilities, evaluation schemes, clubs, associations, co-curricular activities, etc. are explained to all the students, especially the students with diverse needs. Personal care and attention is given to all students concerning career, personal, and vocational matters. The mentor-mentee meetings held are documented by the concerned mentor teachers in the form of Mentoring File/Register.

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- The Mentor-Mentee system is active throughout the academic year. The mentors offered active guidance and take remedial measure if necessary to the mentees as they navigate their under graduate programme of teacher education. The mentors used to collect personal information from their mentees discretely, keeping in mind that certain issues might be sensitive and with care to ensure that all information volunteered by the wards are of their free will. This was done so that the mentor cognizant the context of his mentees and can offer effective assistance.
- For the academic year 2022-2023, the formal group meetings of the mentor with his mentees were conducted on 27.07.2022, 03.10.2022, 29.10.2022, 17.11.2022, 13.02.2023, 02.03.2023, 28.04.2023 and 20.05.2023. Apart from group meetings, the mentors meet the mentee individually on the basis of felt need, observed or addressed.
- The mentors aim to create a conductive environment for their mentees. Additionally, they offer career guidance and personal counselling to ensure that their wards received all the assistance they need.

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2. Peer Feedback / Tutoring

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Report Peer Feedback

Micro-teaching is a training technique to prepare the effective teachers in the society. It is created in a way that is essential for helping student teachers improve their ability to teach. It is a skill-practicing session that was planned so that the student-teachers would become proficient in their teaching techniques. The objectives include comprehending and practicing important skills needed for effective teaching and mastery over the application of teaching skills in classroom transaction.

The micro teaching practice provides student teachers with the essential teaching abilities as a tool for teacher preparation. The practice of micro teaching, which includes the theory of micro teaching, micro demonstrations by teacher educators, and micro teaching practice by student-teachers improved the teaching skills among the student-teachers. The student instructors can appraise themselves during the feedback session that follows the microteaching in order to increase their self-confidence and foster a positive attitude towards teaching. The subject specific teacher educators observe the micro teaching sessions of student-teachers and give feedback to strengthen their skills and modify the flaws. The peer feedback is also collected through frequency table. Self-assessment is made by recording the session and playing it back. The student-teachers practice a variety of teaching skills, including how to introduce a subject/content, probing questions, explaining, application of stimulus variations, reinforcement, use examples to illustrate, use of blackboard, and student participation.

The student-teachers practiced the micro teaching skills from 05.12.2022 to 09.12.2022. The student teachers become adept at their specific micro skills as a result of repeated practices and feedback.

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3. Remedial Learning Engagement



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Report Remedial Learning Engagement

1. Remedial Classes Below Academic Achievers

- The College of Education provides support for improvement of academically relatively below average students through remedial coaching. The students with low performance are identified from their level of understanding concepts and performance in the continuous internal assessments conducted by the college. After the first internal examinations, the Subject Teachers concerned in association with Principal sort out those students who are in need of additional support for the improvement in academics.
- Two student-teachers namely Sri S. Aurobindo and Sri A. Murali have been identified and given remedial teaching in the concerned subjects without affecting the regular class hours. Pedagogical faculty members concerned clarify the doubts of the below average students and handled special classes and provide immediate feedback.
- The intervention practices like breaking the concept into small parts, using mind maps, flow charts, mnemonics, concept maps, individualised instruction to teach the concept, engage students in learning process, providing feedback on performance, re-teaching the difficult concepts are applied to enhance the academic performance. Also, the college provides conducive environment, infrastructure and access to technology for enriching students' learning.
- The College of Education created a Blog in which the faculty members uploaded teaching learning materials for the student-teachers to equip their knowledge and it paves the way to provide remedial coaching to the needy student-teachers.

Assistive Devices and Adaptive Structures (for the differently abled)

1. Awareness Programme on Communicating with Persons of Different Disabilities

Sri Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya College of Education has organised an "Awareness Programme on Communicating with Persons of Different Disabilities for the student- teachers on 24th February, 2023. The focal objectives of the programme are to create awareness among student-teachers on inclusiveness of education, the ways of communicating with person of different disabilities, and to educate them decimate negative attitudes. Dr. K. Rajamanickam, Assistant Professor in Integrated Education for Visually Handicapped (IEVH) handled the session and explained about ways of communication of persons with different disabilities. He has elucidated about Braille system, sign language and advanced tools and techniques that could help the student-teachers to communicate effectively with people who have different disabilities.

2. <u>Orientation Programme on Creating Accessible and Inclusive Classroom for Children</u> <u>with Special Needs</u>

On 16th March 2023, our B.Ed. Student-teachers participated a one-day orientation programme on "Creating Accessible and Inclusive Classroom for Children with Special Needs" organised by Faculty of Disability Management and Special Education (FDMSE), Coimbatore. The first session "Overview about various types of disabilities and implications" was handled by Mrs. Saradha Easwaran, Educational Consultant Sarvae Jana Consultancy Services (SJCS), Coimbatore. She discussed the various types of disabilities as per the RPwD Act, 2016 and explained the implications of the disabilities to the participants. The second session "Curriculum adaptations and different TLMs for children with hearing Impairment" was dealt by Mrs. S.N.Hamsapriya, Assistant Professor, FDMSE, Coimbatore. She explained the need of curriculum adaptation for children with hearing impairment and various teaching learning materials useful in

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inclusive classroom particularly to handle students with hearing impairment. The third session was handled by Dr. K. She gave detailed information about meaning and domains of expanded core curriculum.
