5. Tholampalayam



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Report on Swachh Bharat

Sri Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya College of Education (Autonomous) conducted a Scout Camp from 16.04.2023 to 21.04.2023. Among these days, we planned together one Hill Claiming cum Swachh Bharat Activity at Aranganathar Temple, Palamalai, Coimbatore on 19.04.2023. We obtained prior permission from both the Forest Office and Temple In-charge, who generously agreed to provide lunch for our group.

On 19th April 2023 morning 8:15 am, we departure from our college using buses and bikes. We arrived at Palamalai Hill approximately 9.15am and parked our vehicles before gathering together. 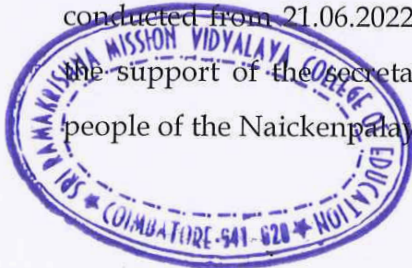

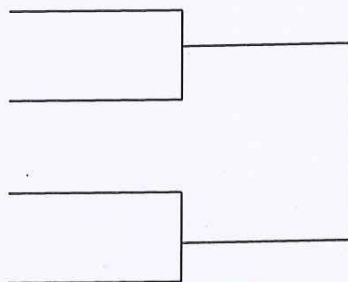
Volleyball Tournament

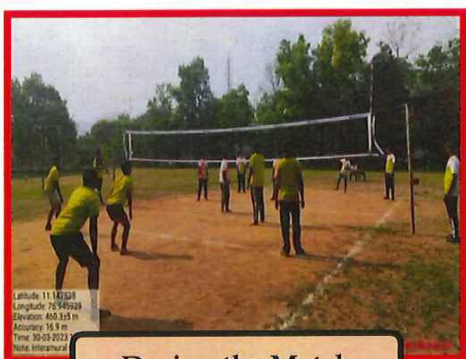

Drawing Competitions for School and College Students



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Report Library Week Celebration



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On November 15, 2022, a debate on the topic "Promoting Reading Habits: Role of Teachers Vs Role of Parents" was organized by the Sri Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya College of Education. The debate aimed at encouraging critical thinking and generate a discussion on the importance of promoting reading habits among children.

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
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Report **Child Art Competition**

a. Tamil Nadu Teachers Recruitment Board (TRB):

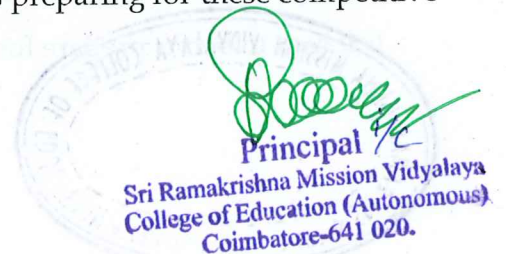



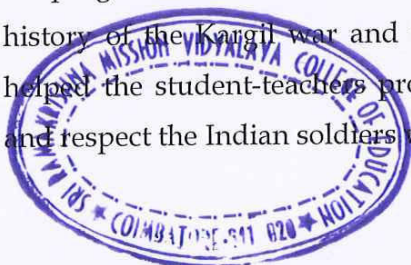
Kargil Vijay Diwas

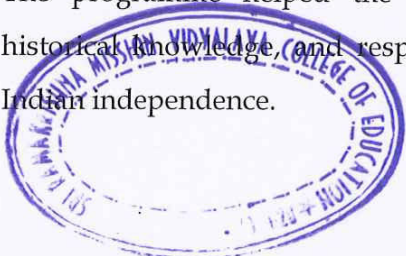
Birth Anniversary of Bhagat Singh


(National Education Day)

Birth Anniversary of Veerapandiya Kattabomman and Rani Velu Nachiyar



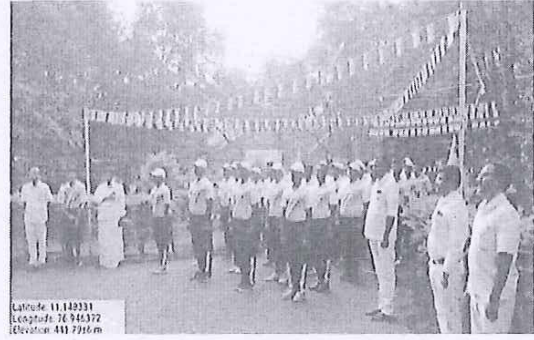

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Report on Republic Day

The student-teachers of our college of education actively participated in the Republic Day Parade held in Vidyalaya campus.




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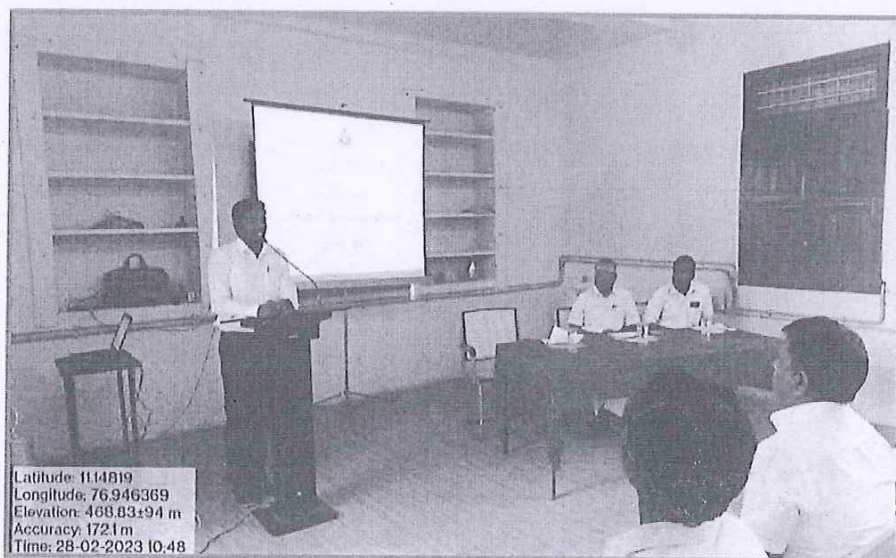
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Report on National Science Day

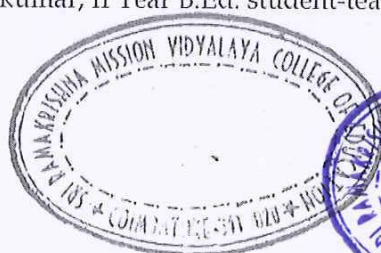
(28th February 2023)
