## 2. Orientation to School Principal / Headmaster and Teachers

The orientation regarding the internship practice was communicated to the school headmaster by the faculty members. Teacher-educators visit the internship schools and discuss with the school heads regarding the student-teachers allotment for the internship, guide teacher allotment, time table preparation for the intensive practice, duties and responsibilities of the student-teachers during their internship, record to be prepared during the time of the internship, and mentor (faculty member) visit for student-teachers class observation.

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#### 3. Orientation to Student-Teachers on Internship

An orientation session on School Internship for the student-teachers was conducted by the College of Education. Dr. G. Subramonian, Principal of the College has explained about the internship teaching. The student-teachers were oriented with principles of internship, internship schools, locality, background of the school atmosphere and school expectations before the internship. They were guided to follow the principles of self-discipline, a sense of responsibility in serving pupils, dedication, sacrifice and commitment in pupils; welfare and growth. These principles and Practice Schools Regulations were clearly spelt out in the orientation. The subjectspecific faculty members have oriented the student-teachers regarding the concerned subjects, records and activities to be completed during the internship programme.

The general regulations of school internship include the following.

The student-teachers shall be expected to mark their presence in the school office both morning and afternoon daily.

They shall have association with the school headmaster, guide teacher

udents and general conduct in the practice schools.

COIMBATORE . 541

- They shall have due respect and cooperation to all staff in the practice school.
- They shall refrain from unprofessional criticism of peers and teachers in the school.
- The student-teacher shall maintain good terms and cordial working relations with cooperating teachers.
- They shall follow rules and regulations of the schools.
- They shall be required to make thorough preparation of lesson plans, schemes of work and other necessary resources.
- They must always have a lesson plan prepared on official lesson plan format while executing any lesson.
- They should enter their classroom with adequate preparation, lesson plans and instructional materials duly signed by the concerned mentor
- They shall not only execute the lessons but mark pupils' work and participate in other co-curriculum activities 'assigned to them by the headmaster.
- They should prepare the blue print and the question paper.
- They shall be expected to conduct at least two tests during internship period on a subject taught.
- They shall engage in organising programmes or participate in any school related programmes with the prior permission from the Headmaster.
- They should engage in all the academic activities assigned by the concerned school Headmaster.
- They shall be responsible for the pupils' welfare and shall exercise the necessary care in all areas of the school curriculum and co-curriculum activities such as clubs, games, school duties etc.
- They shall be expected to complete their record works during the internship duly signed by the guide teacher and headmaster.
- To inform the headmaster any intended absence well in advance to make necessary arrangements.
- They shall not be engaged in any unruly activities. Overall they shall display professionalism during internship

After completion of internship student-teachers shall be expected to submit attendance register, attendance certificate, records, instructional resources, time table and other reports acknowledged by the concerned Head of the school and guide teacher. Also, they are expected to submit the feedback forms from school headmaster, mentor, peer student-teachers and interns from other teacher education institutions.

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# 4. Defining Role of Teachers of the Institution

Teachers play a crucial role in all round development of student-teachers. They support the professional development of student-teachers prior to their internship training by performing a wide range of roles. Before sending the student-teachers to internship schools, the pedagogy teachers train the student-teachers in application of micro teaching skills, writing lesson plans and preparation of teaching aids for proper execution in the classroom teaching. They demonstrate different teaching skills to the student-teachers. They guide the student-teachers regarding the selection of topic, writing the instructional objectives, subject matter to be taught, application of teaching strategies, testing entry behaviour, managing the classroom properly, efficient use of teaching aids and assessment strategies etc. They guide the student-teachers to participate in all the school based activities related to their subjects. They visit the internship schools twice during training phase to observe and analyse their teaching performance and provide necessary guidance and support. Based on their performance their teaching competence is assessed. The concerned faculty members who are in-charge of other activities/ record works also provide guidelines to the student-teachers. They also engage in follow-up activities for the development of student-teachers during the time of internship.

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## 5. Streamlining Mode/s of Assessment of Student Performance

Student assessment enables teachers to measure the effectiveness of their teaching by linking student performance to specific learning objectives. As a result, teachers are able to institutionalise effective teaching choices and revise ineffective ones in their pedagogy. In order to make the student-teachers familiarise with a variety of assessment an evaluation procedure, the faculty members of the College of Education orient student-teachers about the classroom assessment techniques. Student-teachers are trained both in online and offline assessment procedures. It helps them to conduct a diagnostic test and achievement tests following the norms of preparing question papers based on cognitive level of Bloom's taxonomy. The achievement test prepared by them are administered and collected scores are analysed using appropriate statistical techniques are recorded in their test and measurement record. Slip tests help the student-teachers to train the students in their subjects and to provide immediate feedback and remedial teaching as well. Teacher educators also assess the student-teachers' performance during their school visit and offer feedback. The assessment of student-teachers' performance is done in the following ways.

- Self-assessment by the student-teachers.
- Assessment of student-teachers' performance by peers.
- Assessment of student-teachers' performance by fellow interns from other teacher education institutions.
- Assessment by Mentor Feedback.
- Performance evaluation by Head of the institution.



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
