  - i. An initiative for academic collaboration for implementing active learning methods for school children at Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya and SRMV College of Education is planned.  
An academic collaboration is initiated between Ek Kadam Aur Foundation, USA and College of Education for implementing Active Learning methods for the school children (Grades VI to IX).
  - ii. Regular tuitions for school going children at two nearby villages.  
Adhyapana - a free regular tuition programme for school going children is conducted since 01<sup>st</sup> May 2022 at two nearby villages (Vivekanandapuram and Naickenpalayam). Our student teachers handle the tuition sessions.
  - iii. Five proposals are planned to be submitted to AICTE Training and Learning (ATAL) Academy for conducting Faculty Development Programme (FDP)/Professional Development Programme (PDP).

FIVE proposals to conduct ATAL FDPs have been submitted to AICTE through our College of Education on 25<sup>th</sup> April 2022. Dr. G. Subramonian, *Principal*, Dr. M. Jagadesh, Dr. R. Ayyappan, Dr. P. Vel Murugan, K. Karthigeyan, Sri. N. Rajesh Kumar, *Assistant Professors* and Dr. S. Sivasankar, *Director of Physical Education* have submitted the proposals under different thrust areas.

- iv. A Faculty Development Programme for college teachers on "Why EQ measures more than IQ?" by The Mind Academy is planned.

THREE FDPs were organized during the month of May 2022. A total of 155 school and college teachers from SRMV College of Arts & Science (Aided and SF wing), SRMV Polytechnic College, SRMV Swami Shivananda Higher Secondary School (English & Tamil Medium) and SRMV College of Education benefitted from the FDPs.

**B) Eco-system for innovation**

The Institution provides a conducive environment for promotion of Innovation and other initiatives for creation and transfer of knowledge. All required facilities are provided and guidance is extended to the faculty members and student teachers. Few initiatives taken up at the campus include

**i) Active Learning Programme**

**ii) Analytical Thinking**

Stimulation of Analytical Thinking through Mathematics programme conducted for Grades I to IX of SRKV Swami Shivananda Higher Secondary School (Boys Wing).

**C) Outreach Activities**

**i) Unnat Bharat Abhiyan**

The Government of India has selected our college in the process of improving the quality of life and economic well-being of people living in five rural villages namely Keeranatham, Marudur, Belladhi, Agraharasamakulam and Tholampalayam under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) scheme. Subsequently, we have received a Seed Money Grant of Rs.50000/- on 27<sup>th</sup> June 2022.

**ii) Government Observation Home**

The Department of Extension Services is organizing a series of Yoga & Personality Development, Drawing, Vocational Training and Digital Entrepreneurship Skill Training Programmes for the children at Government Observation Home, Coimbatore. A total of Forty-two (42) sessions with a frequency of twice a week have been handled till date on numerous themes for 55 beneficiaries in the Observation Home. 
Faculty members have planned to apply for Major and Minor Research Projects under Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR) for the Year 2022-23.

College of Education emphasises on periodic revision and updation of curriculum based on the academia and industry inputs. Coaching for competitive exams is an integral part of curriculum transaction and as a result of this TWO of our student teachers have cleared TET Paper - I and the results are yet to be published for TET Paper - II.

**B) Academic Flexibility**

Faculty members and student teachers have completed a five-days online training programme on "Animation as Digital Resource for Teaching and Learning" conducted by Central Institute of Educational Technology, NCERT from 26<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> December 2022.

**C) Feedback System**

A well-structured mechanism is in place for obtaining feedback from the stakeholders on the curriculum. Based on the feedback received from students' academic programmes are organized in the institution.

#### A) Honoring Student Diversity

##### i) *Mentoring/ Academic Counselling*

- Mentor – Mentee Meeting was conducted on 03<sup>rd</sup> October 2022. Mentoring helps to guide students in their academic and personal issues. Situational advice motivates them to perform better.
- Deeksharambh (Student Induction Programme) for the I Year student teachers was held from 28<sup>th</sup> October to 08<sup>th</sup> November 2022. Deeksharambh was designed for the new students to feel comfortable, draw their attention towards exploring their academic interests and activities, At the start of the induction, the student teachers learnt about the institutional policies, processes, practices, culture and values.

#### B) Teaching-Learning Process

- The classes for I Year B.Ed Programme (2022-23) commenced on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2022.

#### C) Competency and Skill Development

##### i) *Academic Engagements*

- Microteaching Practice Sessions for I Year B.Ed., student teachers was held from 30<sup>th</sup> November 2022 to 09<sup>th</sup> December 2022. Microteaching introduces the student teacher to a wide range of teaching skills and allows the teacher to practice each skill one at a time till he becomes proficient in the skill.
- II Year B.Ed., student teachers completed their II Phase of internship (III Semester) and commenced their regular classes from 05<sup>th</sup> December 2022. This four-month internship at schools helped the student teachers to enhance their real-time teaching experiences.

##### ii) *Learning Enhancement/ Enrichment inputs*

Students portrayed an Educational Exhibition on 'Active Learning Methodology' and a display of drawing performances by school children held during Gurupuja Child Art Competition.

##### iii) *Developing Teaching Competencies*

Stimulation of analytical thinking through Mathematics skills has resulted in enhancement of teaching competencies among student teachers who handle school classroom sessions from Grades I to IX.

##### iv) *Community Engagement*

Student teachers are engaged in regular tuition classes at two nearby villages as a part of Institution-Society connect initiative. An opportunity to develop their teaching competencies and community engagement is provided to students.


**i) Hands-on-learning through STEM Lab**

**ii) Alumni Interaction**


An alumni interaction is planned to strengthen our alumni network and inturn make use of their academic contribution.
