C) Outreach Activities

i) Unnat Bharat Abhiyan

The Government of India has selected our college in the process of improving the quality of life and economic well-being of people living in five rural villages namely Keeranatham, Marudur, Belladhi, Agraharasamakulam and Tholampalayam under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) scheme. Subsequently, we have received a Seed Money Grant of Rs.50000/- on 27th June 2022.

ii) Government Observation Home

The Department of Extension Services is organizing a series of Yoga & Personality Development, Drawing, Vocational Training and Digital Entrepreneurship Skill Training Programmes for the children at Government Observation Home, Coimbatore.
