COVID - 19 RELIEF SERVICES

In the wake of COVID-19 pandemic, the Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya, Coimbatore, has initiated and done relief services to meet the pressing need of the afflicted, especially the poor and needy for over 41 days from March 31 to May 10, 2020. As a part of relief work Faculty members, non-teaching staff and Student volunteers of Sri Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya College of Education have engaged in COVID – 19 relief activities and services. Relief work can take various forms, such as providing food, medical supplies, and other essential items to those in need, setting up medical camps, and educating people about the importance of following safety measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19. In connection with the global outbreak of Corona-Virus, 51,548 cooked food packets, dry rations of 34,945 kg rice, 18,650 kg dal, 2,785 packets of biscuits, 7,003 liters oil, 2,917 kg suji, 210 kg atta and other groceries of 14, 290 kg were distributed among 7,637 families belonging to 18 villages in Coimbatore district and neighbourhood districts namely Tiruppur and The Nilgiris. Also a number of Transgender, Differently Abled and Migrants were provided with cooked food and dry ration.

Also 13,872 people residing in and around Periyanaickenpalayam Panchayat Union, Mettupalayam and Chettipalayam Panchayat have provided with Medicines like Arsenic Album 30c, a Homeopathy Medicine recommended for boosting immunity.

A 300-bed isolation facility with 24 hour-residential doctors and nurses for asymptomatic COVID patients has been set up in Vidyalaya Indoor Stadium with the support of District Administration, Coimbatore. Also, 10 beds are reserved with oxygen support.

By participating in relief work, members from College of Education have shown their commitment to serving the community and helping those in need. The efforts taken are a testament to the spirit of solidarity and compassion that is needed

to overcome the challenges posed by the pandemic.
