

Sri Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya College of Education has taken the initiative to conduct classes on "Stimulation of Analytical Thinking through Mathematics among students" in grades one to nine at Sri Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya Swami Shivananda Higher Secondary School. These classes are taught by student-teachers from Sri Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya College of Education and Ph.D. scholars from the Department of Mathematics at Sri Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya College of Arts and Science. The classes are held once a week for 45 minutes from August 2, 2022. Online analytical thinking tests are conducted twice a month to assess students' progress.
