

Report of Swachh Bharat Activities

Among these days we planned one Trekking cum Swachh Bharat Activity at Aranganathar Temple, Palamalai, Coimbatore on 19.04.2023. We obtained prior permission from both the Forest Office and Temple In-charge, who generously agreed to provide lunch for our group.

On 19th April 2023 morning 8:15 am, we started from the college using buses and bikes. We reached at Palamalai Hill approximately 9.15 am and parked vehicles before gathering together. In total 42 members (38) students, Sri. B. Sivakumaran, Scout Leader, Sri. R. Lakshmanan, Scout Master, Sri A, Bhaskaran, Scout Master and Dr. S. Sivasankar Camp Coordinator reached the Palamalai. 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Republic Day Celebration - 2023



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
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NATIONAL YOUTH DAY - JANUARY 12
